QBCHECK – TEST TAKER CONSENT FORM

If the test taker does not have legal authority, under the laws of the jurisdiction in which he or she resides, to consent to the administration of the QbCheck test, the parent or legal guardian of the test taker may accept and agree to the foregoing representations and acknowledgements on his or her behalf.

1. INTRODUCTION

You will be taking a QbCheck test under the management of a qualified professional (the “Qualified Professional”). The Qualified Professional has licensed QbCheck for use in its operations. QbCheck is an online tool for both motor and non-motor testing of ADHD, which offers an objective method for measuring the three core symptoms of ADHD – hyperactivity, inattention and impulsivity – in children, adolescents and adults. The tool is used to aid in the assessment and treatment intervention of ADHD, but is not designed to be a stand-alone tool for diagnosis. Accordingly, all diagnostic and (if applicable) treatment, will be carried out by your Healthcare Provider.

QbCheck is provided by Qbtech AB, Kungsgatan 29, 111 56 Stockholm. The Qualified Professional is the data controller (i.e. the responsible party) for all personal data about you which is collected and used within QbCheck, and Qbtech AB is a data processor (i.e. Qbtech AB is only allowed to use such data according to the instructions of the Qualified Professional). Any collection and use of your personal data will be in compliance with applicable data protection laws.

2. THE PROCESSING OF YOUR TEST DATA

The software in QbCheck contains a form where you will provide the following information concerning you as a test person: QbCheck Test taker ID (not your personal identity number), date of birth, gender and country of residence. This information, in combination with data from your test, is processed in the software client and generates a test report, where test data and certain parameters are set out. The transfer of test data between the software client and the server where the test data is stored is encrypted with a certificate.

The information is only available for authorised users within the Qualified Professional and for authorised personnel and consultants of Qbtech AB to provide the QbCheck services to the Qualified Professional.

Qbtech AB may share your test data with third party sub-contractors which support Qbtech AB in the processing of your personal data, such as Qbtech's data storage service providers. Except for this, no individual test data will be shared in any form or made available in any other manner to third parties (unless if required by law or other regulatory bodies) without first obtaining your prior written consent.

However, provided that Qbtech AB removes all Test taker ID information from the records of the test results, thereby permanently anonymising your test data completely, Qbtech AB may use the test results generated by QbCheck for research purposes.

3. YOUR RIGHTS AS A TEST PERSON

If you have questions concerning the Qualified Professional processing of your personal data or would like the Qualified Professional to amend incorrect information, you may contact the test administrator directly or any other person designated by the Qualified Professional.

In addition, you have the right to request personal information that the Qualified Professional holds about you. Such a request shall be made in writing to the Qualified Professional. The Qualified Professional will provide this information to you free of charge within forty (40) days of your request.

4. CONSENT

You as a test person may decide yourself whether information about you will be submitted to, analysed and stored in QbCheck. If you are under 18 years old this decision must be taken by your guardian.
